April 2025 year end report to APM

The Trust was established in 1990 by the late Basil Russell, lifelong gardener at Hole Park and international table tennis referee, to benefit the youth of Rolvenden and surrounding parishes.

The portfolio of Investment funds are managed by Cazenove Capital of £291,731 as at 30 March, down from £291,731 a year previously.

Distributions have increased this year to £12,560. Trustees have contributed £4000 to Newenden play area, £2000 to Newenden Village Hall, and a significant number of other smaller, often personal grants, including 5 distributions to individuals.

Looking forward, we are supporting the refurbishment of the School with up to 6 interactive whiteboards of the highest quality. This will take up to 50% of our income for both the current and next financial years. £6000 in each year

Trustees are keen to receive applications from any individual, or group of young people, or by adults on their behalf who seek assistance with their studies, tuition fees, travel costs or to fund personal development opportunities.
