V1: From the rear Gatefield Cottages on A28, looking north-east, view of Tenterden and St Michael's churches and skyline



V2: From land adjoining Redwood on A28, looking south-east across public footpath AT41, view of Sparkes Gill (ancient woodland) and open countryside beyond



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V3: From Regent Street, looking north-east, view across the cricket pitch and open countryside beyond



V4: From the School Field, footpath AT54A, looking north-west, view of the Windmill



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V5: From the AT49 footpath gate at the SE corner of the churchyard, looking south, view of and across the Thoburn Land towards Gt Maytham



V6: From footpath AT36 at the rear of Coveney's, looking north, view of the open countryside and Winsor and Rawlinson Gills (both ancient woodland)



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V7: From Pix's Lane, looking north-east, view of open countryside and the churches of Tenterden and St Michael's



V8: From the recreation ground in Rolvenden Layne, looking south, view of open countryside and rising ground towards Newenden, Northiam and Fairlight



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V9: From Benenden Road/Sandhurst Lane junction, looking east, view of the listed Windmill



V10: From footpath AT54A, through Inkerman Field on Benenden Road, 360 degree view including St Mary's Church, High Street roovescape (mostly listed buildings), the listed oast at Windmill Farm and listed Saxby's



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V11: From Benenden Road near Mill House, looking south, view of ancient woodland and open views to Newenden Ridge



V12: Mount's Lane, near to Upper Woolwich Oast, looking south-east, across open countryside to Fairlight



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V13: Mount's Lane, opposite Upper Woolwich Oast, looking west, across open countryside to St Mary's Church



V14: From the ridge on footpath AT46 High Weald National Landscape Trail, from Mount's Lane to Tenterden, 270 degree views of listed Kingsgate, Rolvenden Layne and Kent and East Sussex Heritage Railway
